Worship During Holy Week 2013

March 24 Palm/Passion Sunday 9:30 a.m.

We begin with a remembrance of Jesus' triumphant entry into the city of Jerusalem -- your one chance in the year to wave palm fronds! The service then moves into the account in the Gospel According to Luke of Jesus' passion.

March 28 Maundy Thursday 7:30 p.m.

This year, we will sit around a table and join in Jesus' last supper that Passover evening with his closest disciples. A different kind of liturgy.

March 29 Good Friday 7:30 p.m.

The account of Jesus' crucifixion from the Gospel According to John is the focus of this night, when the cross, an instrument of death, becomes a symbol of God's unconditional love for the world.

March 31 Easter Day 9:00 a.m.

Come a little earlier this day. Enjoy a light breakfast and dare to have a butterfly "tattooed" on your face or hand! Be led by the TLC Band in singing of joyful resurrection hymns. Stand with your brothers and sisters in our wonderful faith community and proclaim: "Christ Is Risen!" We conclude with our traditional Easter Brunch out on the patio (weather permitting).

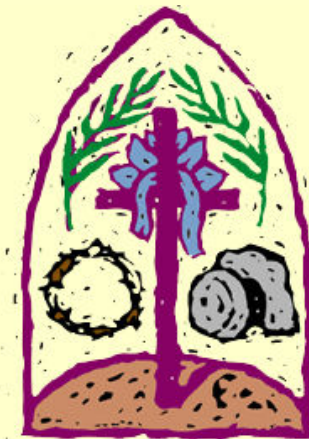
